Express Check –In and Information

Now that you have made your reservation for whitewater excitement with Cascade Raft & Kayak, please familiarize yourself with our check-in procedures so that you can spend more time in Idaho's great outdoors. We are looking forward to seeing you on the river!

- 1. Please arrive at the Cascade Raft River Center at least 10 minutes prior to the departure time of your rafting trip or kayak lesson. You may park in our guest parking lot, located on the south (downstream) side of the gift shop and Rio café building where you will check in.
- 2. Present a completed participant agreement form for each member of your party at the check-in desk and make the final payment for your trip. Each rafter (including minors with parent/guardian signature) must have a signed and completed form in order to go rafting! 3. If your trip requires a wetsuit (the full-day Canyon section), your guides will get

you outfitted at the wetsuit shed located on the river side of the gift shop and café.

- 4. If you need to change into your river attire (for warm days we suggest quickdrying shorts, swimsuits, river sandals or tennis shoes that can get wet, a hat, sunscreen and sunglasses with a strap), changing rooms are located along the walkway adjacent to the lawn area.
- 5. Before you are ready to depart, we suggest locking in your vehicle all items that you do not wish to take with you on the raft. There is a key drop located at the check-in desk. It's tough to swim against the current to look on the river bottom for missing keys!
- 6. Relax on our riverside deck or shaded porch after you have completed checking in and your guides will escort you to the shuttle vehicle when it is time to begin your river adventure.

The Cascade Raft River Center is located on the west side of Idaho State Highway 55 between mile markers 70 and 71 (approximately 5 miles North of Horseshoe Bend and 8 miles South of Banks), and at one of the few places that the highway widens to four lanes of traffic.

You may visit the photo huts along the walkway after your trip to view the photographs

taken of your trip. The gift shop has souvenir T-shirts, hats, and other memorabilia of your rafting adventure. At Cascade Raft and Kayak your safety is our primary concern. Please save any alcohol

consumption for after your trip.
